FiberFest Update by Jane P

Application to the city is finally being reviewed, but we have the go-ahead to start planning.

Saturday, July 27 in Central Park (south of the ditch)

Jane P is point person and will form a working committee; 17 people signed up at the day guild meeting

Total cost for FiberFest 2019 was about \$3,000, including a \$1,000 donation to the library and time for Schacht employees to prep looms. We hope to engage HGB members in preparation. There is a \$300 grant available from Fiber Art Now. Deadline is April 15. There are sufficient funds in the Schacht Outreach Fund.

5-10 booths; reaching out to community partners (Library, CU Museum, Unstable Labs, Stephen Frost, Lulu Faye Knit); HGB study groups; Jane M will reach out to Boulder Beatknits

New Business
