



Material and Supply List – Felted Handbag with Flap

FELTING MATERIALS:

- At least 6-8 ounces of wool roving and/or batts, can be a combination of colors and breeds such as Merino, Corridale, Bergschaf, Finn or your other favorite felting wool.
- Optional items to decorate: silk fabric, silk hankies, ribbons, yarns, silk saris, other fibers, additional silk scrap fabric, tussah silk, etc.

SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT:

- Two pieces of bubble wrap, each about 24-36" square.
- A piece of thick plastic like heavy painter's plastic or floor under layment, which will be used for the handbag resist, which can be purchased in the flooring department at Home Depot or Lowe's on on-line at Amazon.com
 - It usually comes in a 100 sq. ft. roll, 25 'x 4' and is 2 or 3 mm thick. Get the cheapest one you can find since we will be using it for our resist and not for flooring. It usually comes in white, blue or pink. If you can get it without the red words on it, so much the better, but the words are OK too. You can also find this product listed as packing foam rolls.
- A ball brauser or sprayer for applying the soapy water to your project.
- Several old towels
- Eight table risers such as bed risers or PVC pipes (optional).
- Scissors
- Bucket for water
- Your favorite felting soap (liquid soap, olive oil soap)
- Pool noodle
- Two or three old panty hose or knee highs to tie bundle
- Needle & thread to sew on closures

- Instructor will provide thin leather corded strap and hardware.
